HYMN NOTES:

My Hope Is Built on Nothing Less (353)

Written by Edward Mote (1797-1874) this hymn was originally titled "The Immutable Basis of a Sinner's Hope." When telling of this hymn (he wrote more than 100) Mote stated that "one day it came into my mind as I went to labor to write a hymn of the 'gracious experience of a Christian." The hymn was first sung at the bedside of a dying parishioner and met with instant favor and was soon published (1836). Mote was born in London where his parents owned a pub and grew up quite irreligious. He attended a school that did not allow Bible reading. At sixteen he became an apprentice cabinetmaker. His employer took him to hear John Hyatt preach, which Mote pointed to as the beginning of his conversion. He wrote, "O ignorant was I that I did not know there was a God." Converted, he became an English Baptist pastor and is buried in the churchyard of Horsham Baptist Church--his beloved parish which he served for 26 years.


