

HYMN NOTES:

“O Day of Peace” (373)

This hymn was written at the request of the text committee for *The Hymnal, 1982* (Episcopal). They asked for a text on the theme of peace that could be sung to this tune. The two stanzas deal with two aspects of peace: *pax* which is the cessation of conflict, and *shalom*, living in harmony and mutual goodwill. This hymn affirms that peace is always God’s gift, but also recognizes the importance of human responsibility in preparing an environment in which peace can flourish. Stanza 2 is a paraphrase of Isaiah 11:6-9. The tune was composed in 1916 by English composer C. Hubert H. Parry and with a different text, during the interim between the world wars, this emerged as an unofficial British national anthem. It was often sung at public and patriotic events and you may remember it in the film *Chariots of Fire*.

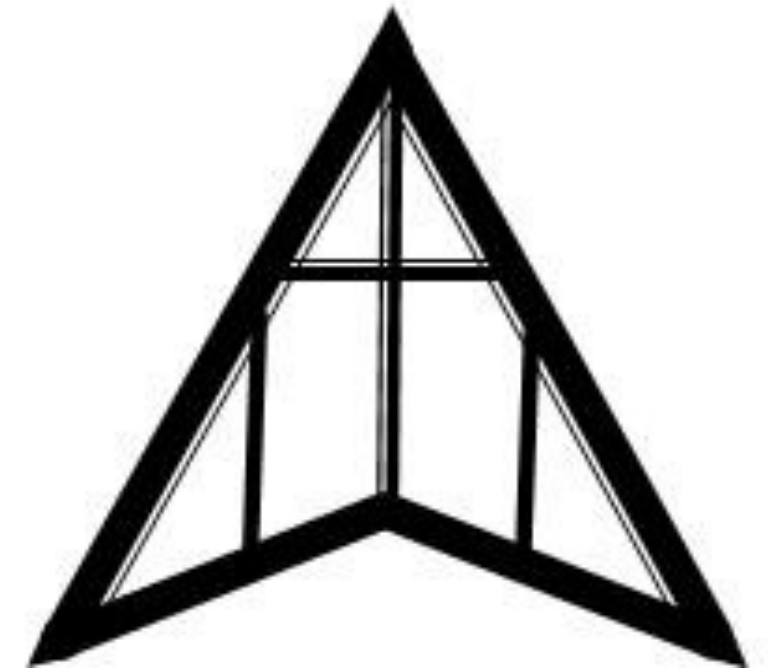
