

New Summer Worship Schedule

Northwood offers several options for worship from September through Memorial Day in May. On Sunday mornings we offer two traditional services at 8:15 and 11:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary. At these two traditional services we follow the Order for Worship for the Lord's Day from the Book of Common Worship. Hymns are led by our Chancel Choir and selected mostly from the new Presbyterian Hymnbook, Glory to God.

In addition, on Sunday morning at 9:30 we have a contemporary worship service, called Ignite, that is also held in the Sanctuary. This service utilizes music provided by a worship band, Voices In Praise.

The sacraments, Baptism and the Lord's Supper, are offered at all services.

Beginning on May 31st, the Sunday after Memorial Day, we will move to a simpler summer schedule through August.

Northwood will offer one traditional service over the summer at 10:30 AM. Those wishing to ride the church van may continue to make calls on Friday for transportation to this service. The contemporary service will take place at 9:00 AM over the summer.

There is something for everyone at Northwood Presbyterian Church and we welcome you to worship with us.

Building Renovation

Dear Northwood Family,

In February I shared information with you about the planned renovations to the Pre-school and Church restrooms located in the main building. Since that time, the bid process has been completed and the bid awarded to the Coastal Reconstruction Group. Demolition of the existing space will begin on Tuesday, May 26.

I want to thank you for your faithful support of this much needed renovation and the many ways it will help us accommodate all those who come here to grow in faith. As of today, we have pledges (some fully paid and some still outstanding to be paid by yearend) and non-pledge gifts (already received) totaling the estimated \$80,000 cost that was projected when this process began. This is a wonderful accomplishment all to the glory of God. Without your faithfulness we could not have moved forward.


Now, if you've ever done a project like this at your own home, you know how these things unfold. The costs that you began to identify in that very first trip to Home Depot or Lowes came more and more into focus as the tradesmen needed were identified and the time to complete the project was nailed down. Our project, here at the church, is no different. The lowest and best bid that came to the table was from the Coastal Reconstruction Group for \$108,000.00. With this information in hand, the Stewardship/Property/Finance Ministry Team agreed to move forward with purpose and in faith knowing that we could essentially borrow the money from ourselves with no need to seek outside financing. Your church is financially healthy and we are very blessed that this is an option.

However, one of the ways we remain financially healthy is to make you, our members and friends, aware of our financial needs so that you might respond as you personally are lead to do. We have a \$28,000 gap between pledges/gifts and the amount of the contract. Whether you have completed a pledge specifically to the building renovation fund, are in the process of doing so or have yet to do so, we invite you to prayerfully consider helping to fill the gap with an additional pledge or gift as you feel led. Again, thank you and if you would like a pledge card or information about how to make your gift online, please call the church office. If you'd simply like to make an additional gift, please mark your check or envelope for the "Building Renovation Fund."

Please remember that in general, during the time of construction, there will be no access to the Library, the Pre-School classrooms or Pre-School office, the children's playground and the Men's or Women's restrooms in the main building. From time to time, parts of the side walk between the church office and the playground will be closed as well. We ask for your patience. Once the construction begins, those areas must be available to the contractor so that the work is not delayed but more importantly, for the ongoing safety and protection of all involved. Restrooms will be available in the Church Office and in the Family Life Center. Additional signage will be in place to help direct you to these areas.
