## **MUSIC NOTES:**

The anthem today includes the ever popular children's hymn "Jesus Loves Me." In this setting, composer Mary McDonald writes for four-part women's voices and adds a compelling original tune using the familiar text by Anna B. Warner (1860). Warner's hymn was included in her sister's novel, *Say and Seal*, 1860. At one point in the story a sick little boy, Johnny Fax, is comforted by his Sunday school teacher. He rocks the child in his arms, and when Johnny asks him to sing, he begins a new song, "Jesus loves me this I know....." The tune was composed for the four-stanza hymn by William B. Bradbury with the composer adding the refrain in 1862.
