Hymn Notes:

"Give to the Winds Thy Fears" (815)

The German hymnwriter Paul Gerhardt wrote this in 1653 in twelve stanzas. It is an acrostic on Luther's version of Psalm 37:5, "Befiehl dem Herren deine Wege und hoffe auf ihn, er wirds wohl machen." (Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act.) Each word of this verse is the first word of successive stanzas. John Wesley in October 1735 was on board a ship bound for Georgia and began to learn German by singing with the Moravians. The first stanza of Gerhardt's hymn may have been a comfort to Wesley during the stormy voyage. He eventually translated it into sixteen stanzas of four lines each and it appeared in his *Hymns and Sacred Poems*, 1739 under the heading "Trust in Providence—from the German." Our *Glory to God* hymnal includes Wesley's original stanzas 9, 10, 13 and 16.


