
MUSIC NOTES: "They Raged at Jesus' Sermon"

Our closing hymn today was written this past Monday by hymn writer and Presbyterian pastor, Carolyn Winfrey Gillette. She is the co-pastor with her husband at Limestone Presbyterian Church in Wilmington Delaware. She describes hymns as prayers-many different kinds of hymns because there are many different kinds of prayers. "We offer God our praise, confess sin, ask for forgiveness, cry out, ask for help, pray for others; and all these speak of the grace of God working in our lives and in God's world." Gillette also writes with specific scriptures in mind as she has done with Luke 4. (Mark 6 is a parallel scripture.) She has written over 100 hymns some of which we have used at Northwood from time to time.




