Hymn Notes:

"I Praise My Maker While I've Breath" (806)

Isaac Watts (1674-1748) wrote two versions of Psalm 146 with much the same words but in two different meters. When John Wesley published his first collection of hymns for use in his colonial parish, Christ Church, Savannah, GA, he included the second version in that small volume—with a few changes. It was one of his favorites and he sang it, instead of any hymn by his brother Charles, as he lay dying. Although it begins with God of creation, it ends with concern for the blind, the troubled, strangers, widows, fatherless children and prisoners. God whose concert reaches to everyone is worthy of praise, in this life and the life to come.


