HYMN NOTES:

"Great Is Thy Faithfulness" (39)

Many times there is an exotic story about the origin of a particular gospel song, but in this case the author wrote in 1955 that there were no special circumstances for his. Thomas O. Chisholm (1866-1960) was a Methodist pastor from New Jersey and based this hymn on two biblical texts, especially as they are worded in the KJV. The first, James 1:17 includes the phrase "the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." The second is Lamentations 3:22b-23: "his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness." This hymn gained great popularity in the mid twentieth century through its use in the Billy Graham Crusades. Originally the tune had no name. The composer suggested the name FAITHFULNESS when one was requested for the Baptist Hymnal, 1956.
