#### Music Notes:

Take My Life (697) The roots of this hymn were first nourished on December 2, 1873, when Frances Havergal (1836-1879) underwent an experience that she called õconsecration.ö She wrote, õ(on that day) I first saw clearly the blessedness of true consecration. I saw it as a flash of electric lightí . There must be full surrender before there can be full blessedness.

öThis experience was still fresh in her memory two months later when she visited friends in Worcestershire. She later wrote, oil went for a little visit of five days. There were ten persons in the houseí .(and) he gave me the prayer, Lord, give me all in this house!ø And He just did! Before I left the house every one had got a blessing. The last night of my visit I was too happy to sleepí and these little couplets formed themselves and chimed in my heart one after another, till they finished with, -ever, ONLY, ALL for Thee!ø

öThese -little coupletsø numbered twelve, and grouping two of them in a stanza has yielded the six stanzas we sing in Glorv to God.

All the solo organ music today is from a work by the 20<sup>th</sup> century German Hermann Schroeder. Schroeder was a college professor and organist at the Cathedral in Trier. He wrote music for the church but also chamber music, concertos and one symphony. The Kleine Präludien und Intermezzi was from 1931. Much of his music matches the style of his German contemporary, Paul Hindemith.


