MUSIC NOTES:

The duet at the offering (8:15 and 11) was composed by the 19th century English composer and organist, Henry Thomas Smart (1813-1879). He spent the majority of his career as organist in parish churches in England. Smart was highly regarded by his contemporaries, but is now remembered only by a few organists and singers. His lasting composition is the hymn tune REGENT SQUARE to which we usually sing "Angels from the Realms of Glory." In the last fifteen years of his life he was nearly blind and composed by dictation.
