HYMN NOTES:

"I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say" #182

This 19th century hymn (1846) is by the eminent Scottish hymnwriter and preacher, Dr. Horatius Bonar. Originally titled "The Voice from Galilee," the hymn centers on three of the sayings of Jesus that encourage us to hear the clear voice of Christ speaking and teaching about finding rest, light and faith. The first half of each stanza gives Jesus' invitation, and the second half gives the response of the author—and our response as well.

The hymn appeared in our former hymnal, *The Hymnal*, 1955 but was dropped from *The Presbyterian Hymnal*, 1990, then restored in *Glory to God*, 2013.
