"O Wondrous Sight, O Vision Fair" (189)

This anonymous 15th century hymn was written for the Feast of Transfiguration, which we note on the Presbyterian calendar today. The music, called DEO GRACIAS, is a stirring English melody from the same era—the victory song "Our King went forth to Normandy"—in celebration of Henry V's triumph over the French at Agincourt, October 25, 1415. Most of the organ music today is all from a work by Michael Burkhardt on that hymntune.


