MUSIC NOTES:

I have shared this story with you before about the Chicago Presbyterian layman, Horatio G. Spafford, author of "It Is Well with My Soul." Spafford was a successful lawyer who some months prior to the Chicago fire of 1871 had invested heavily in real estate on the shore of Lake Michigan and his holdings were wiped out by this disaster. Just before, he had experienced the death of his son. Desiring a rest, he planned a European trip and sent his wife and four daughters on the ship Ville du Havre and intended to join them in a few days. The ship was struck by an English vessel and sank in 12 minutes. Mrs. Spafford survived and arrived in Wales. She cabled her husband, "Saved alone." As Spafford crossed the Atlantic to join her it was thought he penned the text of this hymn near the area where his daughters had drowned. What an amazing example for us of perseverance and faith that he was able to write with conviction, "When sorrows like sea billows roll...it is well with my soul."


