### HYMN NOTES:

#### "Praise, My Soul, the King of Heaven" (620)

While earlier hymn writers made paraphrases of psalms, the author, Henry F. Lyte, added a new dimension by making "poetical interpretations" of the psalm. In 1834 he published this hymn based on Psalm 103. There is a usually omitted fourth stanza based on verses 15-17 that is worth noting:

Frail as summer's flower we flourish; blows the wind, and it is gone, But while mortals rise and perish, God endures unchanging on. Praise Him! Praise Him! Praise the high eternal One!

The tune name LAUDA ANIMA is translated "praise, my soul."
