HYMN NOTES:

"O Love That Wilt Not Let Me Go" by George Matheson (1842-1906) Matheson was born in Glasgow and was the pastor of St. Bernard's Parish in Edinburgh. Although he was blind, he was a great preacher and writer. About this hymn he wrote, "the hymn was composed in the manse on the evening of June 6, 1882...It was the day of my sister's marriage and the rest of my family were staying overnight in Glasgow. Something had happened to me which was known only to myself, and which caused me the most severe mental suffering. The hymn was the fruit of that suffering...I had the impression rather of having it dictated to me by some inward voice...I am quite sure that the whole work was completed in five minutes...It never received at my hands any retouching or correction." It was first published in *Life and Work*, the record of the Church of Scotland (1883).
