
MUSIC NOTES:

The solo organ music today is from a collection by J.S. Bach called "A Little Book for the Organ" (Orgelbüchlein). Included are 46 chorale (hymn) preludes on seasons and themes from the church year. Bach had planned to write 164 preludes and had even chosen all the titles but never completed the task as he eventually moved on to appointments where they would not have a practical use. All are short and most don't exceed 20 measures in length. The piece at the offering is dominated by a musical motif of grief expressing shameful mocking, bitter taunts, a cruel rod and doom. The chromatic movement increases through the work to end—until the light breaks through in the final major chord. The melody is in a canon two octaves apart between the highest voice and the pedals.


