MUSIC NOTES:

Today's anthem at 8:15 and 11:00 is a choral favorite by the otherwise little-known Italian composer Nicola Antonio Zingarelli (1752-1837). A motet from his larger Christus e miserere, this piece--because of its many tricky choral techniques--has often been used in choral contests. Zingarelli was primarily known for his more than 30 operas written before 1811 after which he concentrated on composing and directing church music. He was choir master at St. Peter's in Rome and later at Naples Cathedral.

The closing hymn (#166) is one of a few that relates to that part of the Christian Year from Ash Wednesday to Easter and is a traditional "first Sunday in Lent" hymn. On the subject of the temptation of Jesus, it first appeared in the poet Claudia F. Hernaman's Child's Book of Praise; A Manual of Devotion in Simple Verse, 1873. It is the author's only hymn still in common use of her output of over 150 hymns.


