HYMN NOTES:

"Silence! Frenzied, Unclean Spirit" (180, 181)

This hymn was first included in New Hymns for the Lectionary, 1986 and written by Thomas H. Troeger who is Dean of the School of Theology and Professor at Iliff School of Theology in Denver. He has taught courses in homiletics, worship and congregational song there since 1991. Ordained in the Presbyterian Church in 1970 and in the Episcopal Church in 1999, he is dually aligned with both traditions. Author of more than a dozen books on preaching and worship he is also a poet having written over 80 hymns—eight of them appearing in our hymnal, Glory to God. Today's hymn first retells the story of Jesus exorcising a demon (Mark 1:21-28) then probes the meaning of demons today, and concludes with a prayer for wholeness.


