It refers most of the time to the redemptive power of the River Jordan. The song was also used by Underground Railroad slave conductor Harriet Tubman to warn her fleeing charges how to throw pursuing bloodhounds off their scent. The bell piece ends with a crashing chord symbolizing that 'troubled water' which dissolves into glorious healing with a C major chord.
