HYMN NOTES: "God, who stretched the spangled heavens" (24)

This hymn has been called one of the finest hymns of the 20th century. Written by Catherine A. Cameron, it was first found in *Contemporary* Worship—I (1969), a Lutheran publication. Cameron was born in 1927 in St. John, New Brunswick, Canada, the daughter of well known Presbyterian minister John Sutherland Bonnell. She has written poetry since childhood, and her hymns have appeared in a number of major American hymnals. She is now a U.S. citizen. Cameron said this hymn was "written over a period of several months at a time when I was experiencing a new sense of direction, growth, and creativity in my life. I wrote it to go with the tune AUSTRIA," however, most hymnals—including our Glory to God, use the tune HOLY MANNA. Few hymns speak as eloquently as this about the modern scene. Have we let our inventiveness lead us astray until we are faced with the possibility of self destruction? Has the city become an uncaring place where the lonely drift unnoticed? The hymn ends with a plea to make our work fit into the plans of God. The composer Dale Wood wrote an organ arrangement of the tune in 1989 which we'll hear at the offering today.
