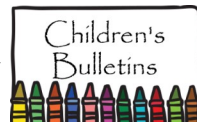


### [Transportation Ministry](#)

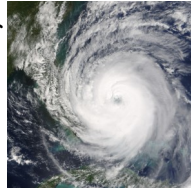
