MUSICAL NOTES

Morning Star tells the Christmas story with dramatic music and evocative narration. There are familiar carols as well as newly composed music by Joseph M. Martin. In ancient cultures, the coming of winter meant darkness, hardship, even death. As knowledge of the seasons' cycles grew, people understood that light would return after the winter solstice. As Christianity spread, Advent became our period of waiting for the Light, and Christmas Eve became the turning point—the longest night—after which Christ would bring his Light into the world.

In astronomy, the morning star is the brightest star, seen in the eastern sky just before the break of dawn. At that moment, the surrounding night is darkest and the morning star appears brightest against its ebony sky. So it is with us—at the end of our long night, the Morning Star appears.


