HYMN NOTES:

"There Is a Place of Quiet Rest" (824) known as "Near to the Heart of God"

Hymns of assurance have often emerged from times of personal grief, and that is again the case here. The author, Cleland B. McAfee (1866-1944), was a Presbyterian campus pastor and choir director. He wrote this hymn after two of his brother's daughters, Anna (age 6) and Lucy (age 3) had died of diphtheria within two days of each other in 1896. The following Sunday was a scheduled communion Sunday and McAfee wrote this hymn, taught it to the choir at their rehearsal on Saturday, and walked with them to the home of his brother where they sang it on the lawn outside the still-quarantined family home. The first public singing occurred the next day in the church service. McAfee's granddaughter was the noted hymn writer Jane Parker Huber (1926-2008) who has five hymns included in our Glorv to God hymnal.


