HYMN NOTES:

We arrive today at the last Sunday in the Christian Year known now as Reign of Christ or Christ the King. Appropriate for today is "Rejoice, the Lord Is King!" that first appeared in *Hymns for Our Lord's Resurrection* (1746) by Charles Wesley (1707-1788). Our hymnal contains four of the original six stanzas (the two omitted stanzas focus on the foes Christ defeats). Some form of this text is now found in almost every Englishlanguage hymnal in the world. The tune DARWALL'S 148TH by John Darwall (1731-1789) was written later. A 1783 copy of this tune in Darwall's handwriting resides in the British Library.

Around 1752, G.F. Handel (1685-1759) wrote a tune for this text. The German born Handel had become an English citizen in 1726 and was a contemporary of the Wesleys. Handel wrote three other tunes for Wesley's hymns. In spite of the great credentials of the composer, Darwall's tune has prevailed.


