MUSIC NOTES: "Good Christian Friends, Rejoice" (132)

Today we hear an organ setting of the tune and sing the carol—whose origin goes back to the 14th century. The original words are said by a 14th century writer to have been sung by angels to Henry Suso (d. 1366). He was a mystic, who "was drawn in thereby to dance with his celestial visitors." The text uses both Latin and German—called 'macaronic'—and was used to teach the Christmas story to uneducated people. The music was meant to be danced and church, more accustomed to austere plainsong and motets, decided that the popular music of the day was too good to miss. As Martin Luther said, "Why should the devil have all the good tunes?" The first line of each stanza was altered from "Good Christian men..." to "Good Christian friends" when published in the *Lutheran Book of Worship* (1978). The tune name, IN DULCI JUBILO means "in sweet shouting, or jubilation." We use this carol today (perhaps a bit early) to complement the lectionary scripture readings especially, Philippians 4:4 (Rejoice in the Lord, always....) and Luke 3 (describing the good news of the Christ and his power to save).
