HYMN NOTES: During these weeks of stewardship emphasis we will see and hear many references to 'opening doors' through sermons, music, hymns and visuals. Our opening hymn today was born from the dedication of a new worship building for Overlake Park Presbyterian Church in Bellevue, Washington. The theme for their move into the new facility was "Open the Doors." The pastor wrote, 'In April 1987 there was a fire that very quickly destroyed the (worship) building. On the Sunday following the fire, we gathered in front of the burned out building and had a service where we closed the doors for the final time and then moved to our Fellowship Hall....for two years. We used the theme "Open the Doors" for the financial campaign for the new building.'

The congregation had suffered four years of sadness: the sudden death of a parish associate, departures, disappointments, and disease—all this in addition to the fire. They persevered through it all and with patience, prayer and sacrifice were able to sing this hymn as they opened the new doors for Christ in the new building.
