HYMN NOTES:

"It Came upon the Midnight Clear" (#123)

This text was written by Edmund H. Sears, a Massachusetts Unitarian minister, who was deeply involved in the "social gospel." It was first published in The Christian Register in December 1849. This was the first of the carol-like hymns from American poets. Hymns stressing the social message of Christmas (peace on earth, goodwill) are distinctly American. Based on Luke 2:13-14, it is a call for us to respond to the song of the angels and to send back to heaven the message that we will make peace on earth. After 2000 years, we are still working on that.
