MUSIC NOTES:

The music at the offering today is an arrangement of a 15th century German carol that was part of a mystery play acted in church around the crib. The refrain of the carol is:

He came among us at Christmastide, at Christmastide in Bethlehem; Men shall bring him from far and wide Love's diadem: Jesus, Jesus,

Lo, he comes, and loves, and saves, and frees us!

The organ arrangement is by Keith Chapman, who as a child organ prodigy, began organ study at age 5. In 1966 at the age of 20, he was appointed organist at the famous Wanamaker Department Store organ—the largest playable organ in the world. He helped make this organ world famous through his concerts and radio broadcasts during his 23 year tenure. Tragically, he and his wife were killed when their twin-engine plane (which he was piloting) crashed in the Colorado Rockies in 1989.


