HYMN NOTES:

"Let Us Break Bread Together" (525)

The original version of this African-American spiritual consisted of the now third stanza beginning with the words "Let us praise God..." The spiritual was apparently used as a gathering song for secret religious meetings held before sunrise by slaves in Virginia. After 1676, the colony, afraid of group protests and attempted escapes, forbade the use of drums and horns by the slaves as a means for gathering. This spiritual and others took the place of those drums. Sometime after the Civil War the first two stanzas were added and it became a hymn for use during Holy Communion. "The rising sun" could refer to an ancient custom of worshipping toward the east. In one of the last verses in the Old Testament, Malachi prophesied that the "Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in his wings" (Malachi 4:2), which is usually understood as a reference to the coming Christ.


