As of December 18, 2015, the IRA Charitable Rollover was passed by Congress and signed into permanent law by the President. If you are 70 ½ or older and own an IRA, this new law allows you to avoid taxes when you transfer funds from your IRA directly to a qualified charity. You can transfer up to \$100,000 annually without recognizing the distribution as income. To benefit, you must make your gift before December 31.
