HYMN NOTES: "Come Now, O Prince of Peace" (103)

Likely a new hymn to nearly all of us, this 1988 hymn was penned by a Korean native, Geon-yong Lee, who was born in 1947 in Pyongannamdo in what is now North Korea. His father was a minister and following the Korean War, the family moved in 1953 to what is now South Korea where Mr. Lee grew up in Seoul. After studying music in Germany he returned to Korea where he has had a career in teaching composition and university administration. He also was choirmaster of the Anglican Cathedral in Seoul. Mr. Lee is among the many Anglicans in his country actively working toward reunification of the Korean peninsula.

This text and tune were written for the opening worship service of an international conference held in Geneva with the World Council of Churches on the peace and reunification of Korea. Although not originally intended for Advent, the opening line (Come now, O Prince of Peace...) uses that messianic title drawn from Isaiah 9:6—today's scripture lesson. Of course, the very word "advent" is from the Latin *adventus*, meaning "coming." Each stanza is a petition, requesting the "Prince of Peace" to "come" to us and to "reconcile" us to "all people" and "all nations."
